
And lastly, huge thanks go to each and every trainer for their dedication to ETAG and high level professionalism.

Teaching Knowledge Test

The Teaching Knowledge test (TKT) is a test for the teachers of English from Cambridge University. TKT gives teachers a strong foundation in the core areas of ELT methodology. It is ideal for all teachers, and is also suitable for people who would like to teach English but do not have a teaching position. Teachers who wish to take TKT in Georgia may do a preparation course in ETAG before taking the test or prepare for it independently. TKT test will take place at British Council in Tbilisi on 16 January, 2010. The time to register for the January test is 15 - 25 November 2009. Candidates should submit a completed application form at the British Council on these days. The test fee for all three modules is GBP 93 (31 for each module).

Over 90 teachers have already taken the TKT in Georgia, so do not think twice! Register in November and be an internationally certified English Teacher.
